Dear Mr. Kieling:

The purpose of this letter is to withdraw the referenced request for an extension of storage time for contact-handled transuranic (CH TRU) mixed waste in storage in the Waste Handling Building Container Storage Unit (WHB Unit) at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) facility.

As discussed in the referenced letter dated November 15, 2019, the WIPP facility experienced an unexpected electrical problem on November 14, 2019. Power was not available to the Interim Ventilation System (IVS) due to the electrical problem, therefore, the ventilation required to emplace the containers described in the referenced letter was not available. The electrical problem was addressed on November 15, 2019 and power to the IVS was restored. The payloads were successfully downloaded on November 16, 2019. Therefore, an extension of storage time is no longer needed.

We certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under our direction or supervision according to a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted.
