In addition, in accordance with contract clause H.90 (work not funded by CBFO) due to the fact that Generator Site funding is not included in the annual funding guidance provided to the contractor, it is not included in the Section B table estimated values. For this Modification, those amounts are reflected in a subCLIN in Section B and the contract ceiling in the amount of \$14,905,343.58. The result of the actions detailed above is an increase to the total contract value of \$14,905,343.58. The contract is modified as follows:
