## **WIPP UPDATE: May 12, 2014**

## Latest underground entry reveals more information about event

Workers entered the WIPP underground facility again on Saturday to further investigate Room 7 of Panel 7, the suspected scene for the February 14 radiological event.

Using a portable camera on an extender, workers were able to take pictures over the top of stacked waste containers. The photographs showed evidence of melted plastic and rubber on 55-gallon drums and standard waste boxes, indicating the production of heat likely occurred in the room. Experts from the Department of Energy Accident Investigation Board, several national laboratories, URS Professional Services and Tetra Tech are reviewing the visuals collected on Saturday to continue to get a better understanding of the cause of the event.

During the next entry, workers will use another new technique to maneuver the camera in among the various waste containers for additional visual angles.
