WIPP UPDATE: April 10, 2014

New environmental sampling data shows no detectable contamination

New water and air sampling data, including rooftop runoff samples, collected during a rain shower at the site on March 16 showed no detectable contamination levels.

Air monitoring results collected on March 25 from the fixed air monitoring stations near WIPP also showed no detectable levels of contamination. This is consistent with previous results reported by an independent monitoring group from the Carlsbad Environmental Monitoring and Research Center (CEMRC).
