## **WIPP UPDATE: June 6, 2014**

### **Work continues to obtain video footage in Room 7**

A team consisting of members from WIPP, the Los Alamos National Laboratory, the Savannah River National Laboratory, and the Accident Investigation Board is working to develop a platform system that eases the process and improves camera access to evaluate waste containers in Room 7 of Panel 7. To date, employees have been unable to examine waste containers at the back of Room 7. The team is researching various technologies and applications that will allow them to access these areas with cameras. Entries into the underground facility are currently on hold while the filters are being replaced.

### **Filter replacement activities continue on schedule**

The filter change-out team from the Savannah River Site continues preparing for replacing filters at WIPP. The team has participated in extensive training to practice for the actual filter replacements to help ensure safe and seamless completion of the work. The filter replacement work will be conducted at night due to extremely high daytime temperatures and is scheduled to begin next week.
