# Event Investigation Continues




- Based on evidence from last week's entry, NWP made decision to issue an Occurrence Report
- One hypothesis is nitrate salts in a LANL waste stream COULD be a contributor to the event
- Compensatory measures included halting LANL shipments, and working with Waste Control Specialists to take appropriate precautions

# Event Investigation Continues *(continued)*

- CBFO/NWP working closely with national labs at Los Alamos and Savannah River to perform chemical & isotopic analysis
- This will provide us another piece of the puzzle
- It is still too early to determine whether this is the source of the event; we will continue to look at all scenarios

# Preparations for the Next Underground Entry



- Developed telescoping boom to help obtain overhead photos from suspected event scene
- We will also collect additional samples from Panel 7 to help with the forensic analysis

# Environmental Sampling Update

- 3 new water samples collected March 26 from rooftops, roadway drainage
- Remaining new environmental samples all below Minimum Detectible Concentrations
  - 14 sediment samples
  - 19 soil samples
  - 32 vegetation samples
