
- WIPP is committed to communicating with the public

Filter Change-out

- Activity is progressing smoothly
 - Filter unit one
 - High-efficiency and moderateefficiency filters changed
 - HEPA filter aerosol testing completed
 - Work on filter unit two is ready to begin

- Three main options under consideration:
 - 1. VJT tool using 2" titanium rods
 - Gantry camera
 - 3. Existing process (pole and camera)

Lab/Sampling Results

Air Sampling

- 15 samples obtained 5/13 below minimum detectable concentration
- 30 samples obtained between 5/20 – 5/27 below minimum detectable concentration

Soil Sampling

- Two (2) samples obtained on 5/15
 - One (1) below minimum detectable concentration
 - One (1) sample showed low contamination



Lab/Sampling Results

- Water Sampling
 - Three (3) samples obtained between 5/24 and 5/28 below minimum detectable concentration
