- A. Construct a new fiber loop around the WIPP Site with lead-ins to the new fire alarm panel locations throughout the site, to include trenching to a nominal one foot depth.
- B. Installation of a new fire detection and alarm communications network, independent of the existing system.
- C. Installation of new fire alarm panels and appurtenances in each of the WIPP Site buildings.
- D. Testing and commissioning each new fire alarm panel after installation.
- E. Installation of centralized fire alarm control panel(s) in the WIPP Site Central Monitoring Room (CMR).
- F. Linking the new fire detection and alarm communication network, and by extension all new fire alarm panels, to the centralized fire alarm control panel(s) located in the WIPP Site CMR.
- G. Testing and commissioning of the installed new fire detection and alarm system to validate operability of the system; and, to validate CMR data.

A Pre-proposal Conference will be conducted at the WIPP Site to discuss all aspects of the proposed Scope of Work and to tour the proposed work area, on or about <u>May 9, 2019</u>.
